
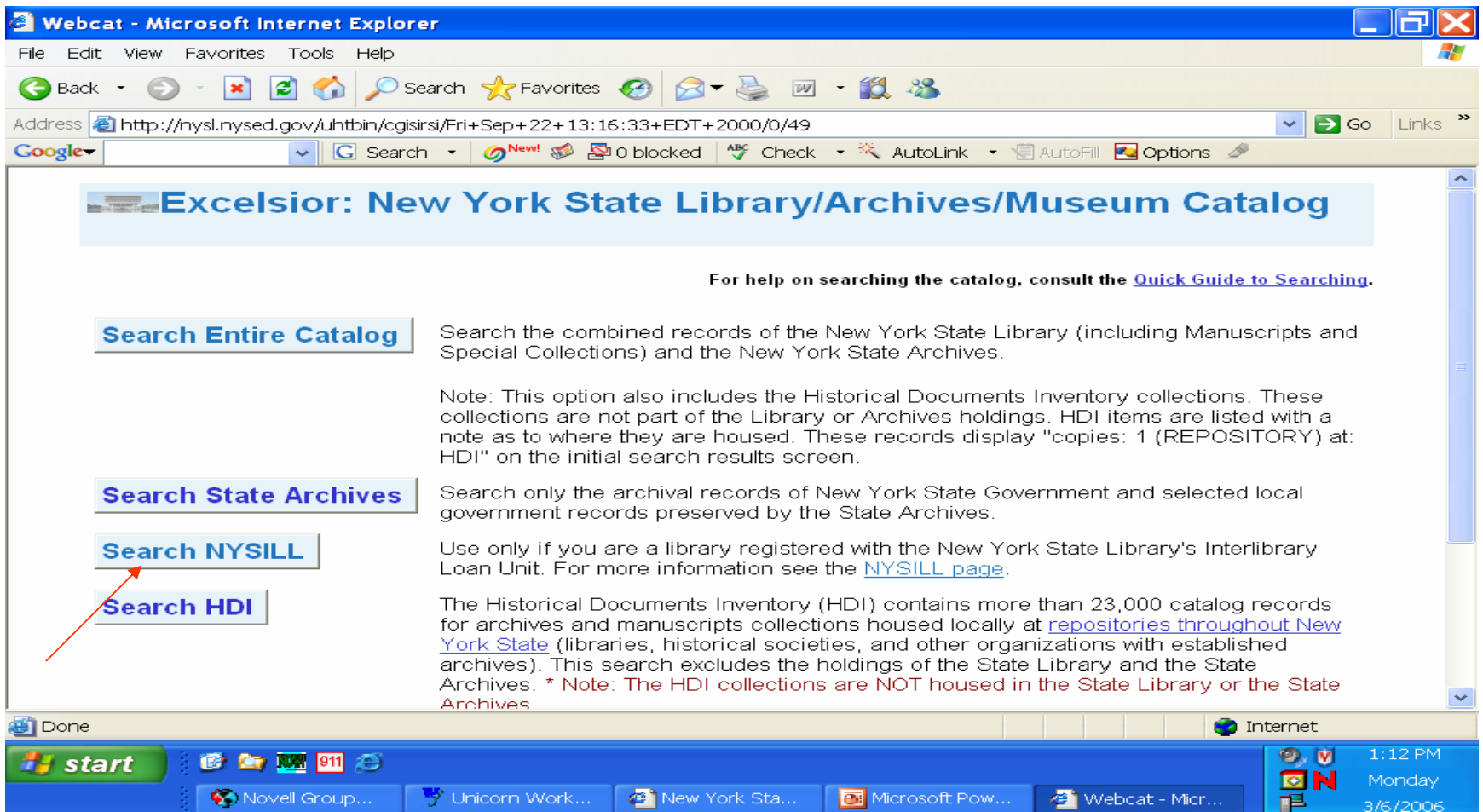


# GETTING STARTED IN NYSILL

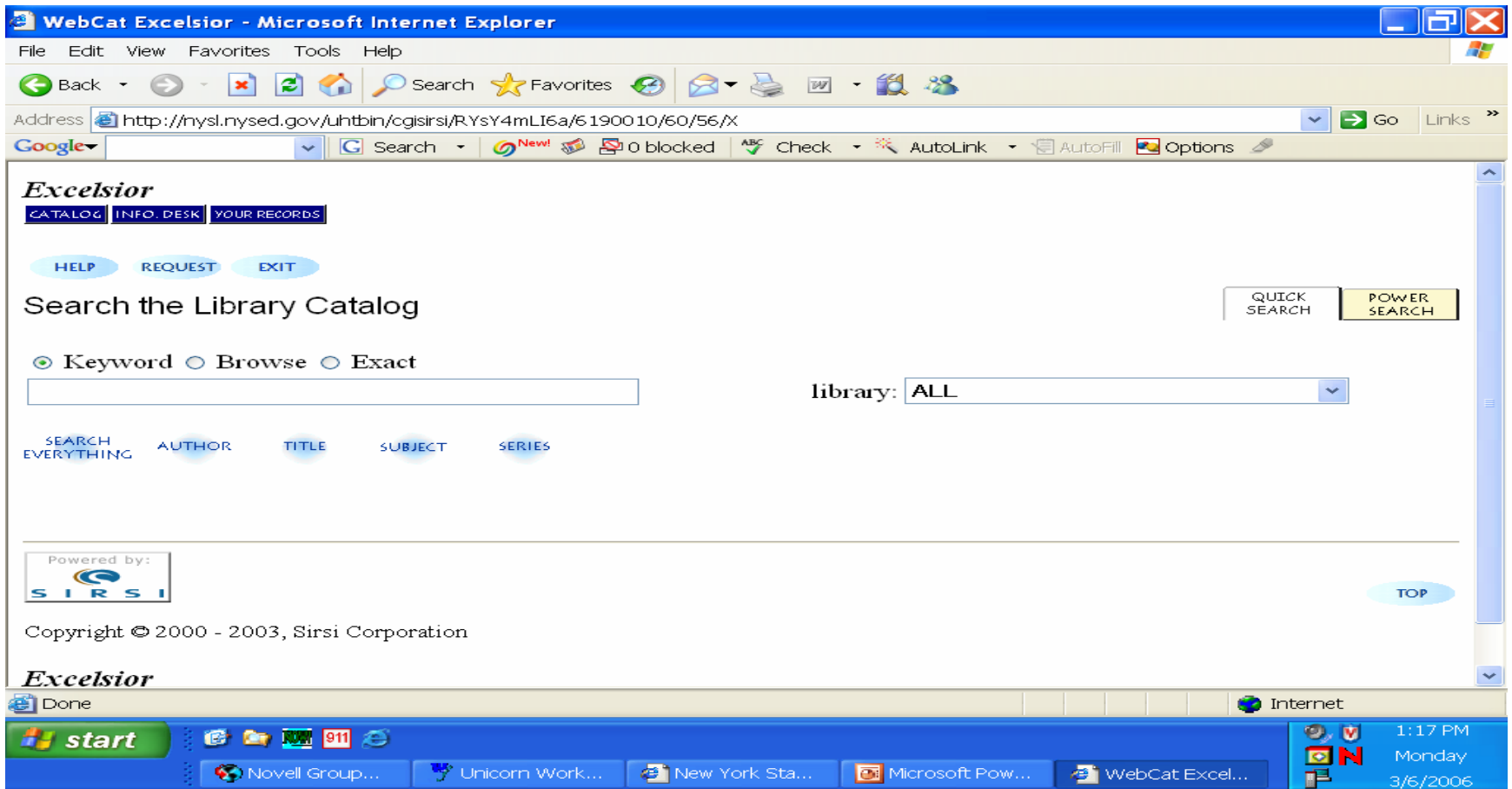
first, go to the Library's website
