


TOWN OF LOCKPORT

I hope you had a wonderful winter and are now ready for the great weather ahead.

Some reasons why our residents love the Town of Lockport: One hundred year infrastructure plan, five year budget projections, parks and recreation, Community Day, Fall Festival, Family Movie nights, credit card processing, fun recycling incentives, great snowplowing, www.transitnorth.com, www.elockport.com, www.lockporteconomicdevelopment.com, website information, maps, newsletters, LCTV live meetings, Supervisors LCTV show, Town Board LCTV show, six years of balanced budgets with a \$73 per household fee decrease since 2006, sixty new businesses in the past seven years with an additional 15 business expansions, and best of all, NO TOWN TAX!

Business Development: This year will be a busy time in your Town. Wal-Mart will begin constructing their new location at the site of the old Lockport Mall. The architectural design of this Wal-Mart will set the tone for future development within the Transit North Corridor.

So far we have 8 retail projects and 2 industrial projects under review for the 2011 construction year. As the national economy continues its recovery, we continue to bring you new retail and manufacturing jobs. Our aggressive approach to business development continues to achieve great results! Our IDA and Town Board have put together an action plan to bring new businesses like Yahoo, Delta Pro, Introl Design, Basetek Products and Spartek Polycom. Parks: Day Road Park will get new restrooms this year. Our Highway Department, under the direction of Highway Superintendent David Miller, will do the work saving the taxpayers thousands of dollars. We look forward to the new restroom facilities as our designed plans for the Day Road Park reach their conclusion.

Day Road Park will also become the home field for the Lockport High School Cross Country Team. We welcome the Lockport School District as our latest partner at the Day Road Park. We hope the location serves them well as a safe and unique cross country track for their home meets.

Lytle Nature Preserve: All the permits have been

secured and Greenway Funds approved for the construction of the expanded parking lot and southeast entrance into the Lytle Nature Preserve. Again the Town of Lockport Highway crew and David Miller the Highway Superintendent will be working to make the Lytle Nature Preserve accessible for your enjoyment. Look for construction to begin later this year.




Participants will receive a certificate at the completion of the course and NCCC will keep a permanent record of coursework completed.
