

**State Aid for Library Construction  
Fiscal Years 2013/2014 and 2014/2015  
A Report to the Legislature**

**Introduction**

This mandated report provides an update to the New York State Legislature regarding the impact of *Chapter 498 of the Laws of 2011*, which amended §273-a of the Education Law relating to State Aid for Library Construction, effective for the first time in State Fiscal Year 2012/2013. This report will focus on Fiscal Years 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 State Aid for Library Construction, the second and third year of project awards under the new provisions of *Chapter 498*. State Aid for Library Construction is a formula aid program administered by the New York State Library, a unit of the Office of Cultural Education in the State Education Department. The program is administered in partnership with New York State's 23 public library systems and the Dormitory Authority of New York State.

The provisions of *Chapter 498* mandate this report as follows:

***“The commissioner shall submit to the temporary president of the senate and the speaker of the assembly an annual report describing those projects that have received state funding of greater than fifty percent of project costs and the communities to be served by those projects.”***

The first mandated report, *State Aid for Library Construction Fiscal Year 2012/2013* was submitted to the Legislature in May 2014. It provided context and background information about the State Aid for Library Construction Program. *Appendix D* in that first report provided information about the continuing need for a State-funded construction program and *Appendix E* described the overall program and its impact on public libraries and local communities. **Background**

Beginning in 2008, public library systems reported that several public libraries with construction needs were unable to participate in the State Aid for Library Construction Program because of the 50 percent or higher local matching requirement. Many of these libraries were located in an economically disadvantaged community or were serving one or more economically disadvantaged communities.

In addition, system leaders noted that local communities would benefit if libraries could apply for matching State funds to purchase vacant land in preparation for building a new

facility or expanding an existing facility. While the purchase of land with a building was allowable under §273-a of the Education Law, the purchase of vacant land was not. In order to address these two issues, and further expand local library access to State funding for construction and renovation projects, the Legislature enacted *Chapter 498 of the Laws of 2011*. The changes to the law were applied for the first time during the Fiscal Year 2012/2013 funding cycle, and included:

- A “flexible match option” of State funding for up to seventy-five percent of the project cost for library buildings serving economically disadvantaged communities.

*“...state aid may be provided for up to seventy-five percent of the total project approved costs for buildings of public libraries that are located in an economically disadvantaged community.”*

*“Each application shall...contain documentation, where such an application requests state aid in an amount greater than fifty percent, demonstrating how the project will address the service needs of one or more economically disadvantaged communities. Such documentation may demonstrate need through poverty rates, concentrations of English language learners, low high school graduation rates, limited fiscal capacity or other relevant factors...”*

- Authorization for a library board to purchase vacant land in preparation for building a new library building or expanding an existing facility.

*“State aid shall be provided...for projects for the acquisition of vacant land and the acquisition, construction, renovation or rehabilitation, including leasehold improvements, of buildings of public libraries and library systems chartered by the regents of the state of New York or established by act of the legislature...”*

### **Overview of Fiscal Year 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 Project Awards**


The State Library funded 185 projects with the \$14 million in capital funds provided in the Fiscal Year 2013/2014 State Budget. These projects are the second round of project awards impacted by the changes in *Chapter 498*. In August 2015, the State Library announced 182 project awards to be supported by the \$14 million in capital funds provided in the Fiscal Year 2014/2015 State Budget. These projects are the third round of awards impacted by the changes in *Chapter 498*.


**State Aid for Library Construction

Libraries will be expending the Fiscal Year 2013/2014 project funds on activities in the following major categories:

- **\$1.54 Million - Construction/Expansion/Acquisition** projects including the construction of new library buildings and additions, the purchase and renovation of existing buildings, and the purchase of vacant land.
- **\$5.18 Million - Renovation** improvements such as creating and reconfiguring new library space and upgrading wiring to accommodate new technologies in an existing facility.
- **\$3.5 Million - Energy Efficiency** projects that involve the installation of solar panels, provide for geothermal wells, upgrade heating and cooling systems, provide for lighting upgrades (including LED lighting), and make possible upgrades to window and roofing materials.
- **\$2.52 Million - Access for people with disabilities** such as improving access to library building entrances and all areas of library buildings, providing accessible restrooms, installing elevators and installing listening devices in meeting rooms.
- **\$1.26 Million - Safety-related** improvements such as upgrading fire alarms and installing security systems, improving walkways and improving parking lot safety.

Libraries will be expending the Fiscal Year 2014/2015 project funds on activities in the following major categories:

- **\$1.12 Million - Construction /Expansion/Acquisition** projects including the construction of new library buildings and additions, the purchase and renovation of existing buildings, and the purchase of vacant land.
- **\$4.48 Million - Renovation** improvements such as creating and reconfiguring new library space and upgrading wiring to accommodate new technologies in an existing facility.
- **\$3.36 Million - Energy Efficiency** projects that involve the installation of solar panels, provide for geothermal wells, upgrade heating and cooling systems, provide for lighting upgrades (including LED lighting), and make possible upgrades to window and roofing materials.
- **\$2.38 Million - Access for people with disabilities** such as improving access to library building entrances and all areas of library buildings, providing accessible restrooms, installing elevators and installing listening devices in meeting rooms.
- **\$2.66 Million - Safety-related** improvements such as upgrading fire alarms and installing security systems, improving walkways and improving parking lot safety.


**Fiscal Year 2013/2014 and Fiscal Year 2014/2015 State Aid for Library Construction Awards with a State Match Over Fifty Percent**

Thirty-eight percent of the Fiscal Year 2013/2014 awarded projects (70 of the 185 projects) were able to take advantage of the option to receive State funding for a flexible match of up to 75% of project costs, with thirty-one percent (57 of the 185 projects) receiving the full 75%. *Appendix A* includes a list of these seventy projects.



Westport Library Association in Essex County - Energy Efficient Window Project


As illustrated in the chart below, 9 percent of the available Fiscal Year 2013/2014 capital appropriation of \$14 million, or \$1,276,375, funded that portion of the 70 project awards that exceeded 50 percent.

Thirty-eight percent of the Fiscal Year 2014/2015 awarded projects (69 of the 182 projects) were able to take advantage of the option to receive state funding for a flexible match of up to 75% of project costs, with twenty-eight percent (51 of the 182 projects) receiving the full 75%. *Appendix C* includes a list of these 69 projects.

As illustrated in the chart below, 7 percent of the available Fiscal Year 2013/2014 capital appropriation of \$14 million, or \$963,658, funded that portion of the 69 project awards that exceeded 50 percent.

### **Overview of Criteria Used to Document Eligibility for State Match Over 50%**

The flexible State match of over 50 percent was requested for 70 projects in Fiscal Year 2013/2014 and 69 projects in fiscal year 2014/2015. Library systems used one or more of the criteria included in §273-a of the Education Law to document a project's eligibility for the flexible match.

The criteria used most often by the library systems were poverty rates, household income levels, unemployment rates, and free and reduced school lunch eligibility data from the New York State Education Department. Some systems used education levels, the number of English language learners, and/or housing values and foreclosure data from the United States Census Bureau.

Appendices B and D lists the types of eligibility criteria used to document match eligibility for each project.

### **Overview of Project Awards for the Purchase of Vacant Land**

In Fiscal Year 2013/2014 and Fiscal Year 2014/2015 the State Library awarded funds for one project for the purchase of vacant land:

- **Galway Public Library** (Saratoga County)- A project award of \$77,625 to acquire a site to build a new library. (FY13/14)

## Conclusion

Based upon the information and data described in this statutorily mandated report, the New York State Education Department has determined that changes enacted to §273-a of the Education Law by *Chapter 498 of the Laws of 2011* continue to have a positive impact on public library construction and renovation projects for facilities that are located in economically disadvantaged communities.

Public library facilities located in economically disadvantaged communities benefitted from the 139 construction and renovation projects which received the flexible State match option for the Fiscal Years 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 funding cycles. Thirty-seven libraries applied for construction funding for the first time in Fiscal Years 2013/2014 and 2014/2015. Of those, nineteen requested the flexible match.

The flexible match continues to enable more libraries to:

- Improve access to library programs and services for people with disabilities
- Accommodate new technologies
- Increase energy efficiency
- Enhance spaces for programs and collections
- Improve customer service
- Recover from Natural Disasters
- Create sustainable community partnerships, and
- Leverage other grant funds.
