State Aid for Library Construction Fiscal Year 2016/2017 A Report to the Legislature

Introduction

This mandated report provides an update to the New York State Legislature regarding the impact of *Chapter 498 of the Laws of 2011*, which amended §273-a of the Education Law relating to State Aid for Library Construction, effective for the first time in State Fiscal Year 2012/2013.

Fiscal Year 2016/2017 was the fifth year of State Aid for Library Construction projects funded under the following provisions of Chapter 498:

"...state aid may be provided for up to seventy-five percent of the total project approved costs for building of public libraries that are located in an economically disadvantaged community."

"Each application shall...contain documentation, where such an application requests state aid in an amount greater than fifty percent, demonstrating how the project will address the service needs of one or more economically disadvantaged communities. Such documentation may demonstrate need through poverty rates, concentrations of English language learners, low high school graduation rates, limited fiscal capacity or other relevant factors..."

"The commissioner shall submit to the temporary president of the senate and the speaker of the assembly an annual report describing those projects that have received state funding of greater than fifty percent of project costs and the communities to be served by those projects."

Three earlier reports to the legislature, *State Aid for Library Construction Fiscal Year 2012/2013*, *State Aid for Library Construction Fiscal Years 2013/2014 and 2014/2015*, and *State Aid for Library Construction 2015/2016* provide context and background information about the State Aid for Library Construction Program. These earlier reports are also posted on the New York State Library's website.

As stated in the conclusion for this year's report, the Legislature's enactment of *Chapter 498 of the Laws of 2011* has helped to expand local library access to State funding for construction and renovation projects. The "flexible match option" of State funding for up to seventy-five percent of the project cost for library buildings serving economically disadvantaged communities continues to have a positive effect on local libraries and the communities they serve.


Overview of Fiscal Year 2016/2017 Projects

State Aid for Library Construction is a formula aid program administered by the New York State Library, a unit of the Office of Cultural Education in the State Education Department. The program is administered in partnership with New York State's 23 public library systems and the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York.

State Aid for Library Construction formula funding supported 216 projects with the \$19 million in capital funds provided in the Fiscal Year 2016/2017 State Budget. Fiscal Year 2016/2017 project descriptions are posted on the State Library's website at: http://www.nysl.nysed.gov/libdev/construc/19m_pls17.htm.

Libraries will be expending the Fiscal Year 2016/2017 project funds on activities in the following major categories:

- ✓ **\$1.71 Million – Construction/Expansion/Acquisition** projects including the construction of new library buildings and additions, the purchase and renovation of existing buildings, and the purchase of vacant land.
- ✓ **\$5.89 Million – Renovation** improvements such as creating and reconfiguring new library space and upgrading wiring to accommodate new technologies in an existing facility.
- ✓ **\$4.37 Million – Energy Efficiency** projects that involve the installation of solar panels, provide for geothermal wells, upgrade heating and cooling systems, provide for lighting upgrades (including LED lighting), and make possible upgrades to window and roofing materials.
- ✓ **\$3.23 Million – Access for people with disabilities** such as improving access to library building entrances and all areas of library buildings, providing accessible restrooms, installing elevators and installing listening devices in meeting rooms.
- ✓ **\$3.80 Million – Safety-related** improvements such as upgrading fire alarms and installing security systems, improving walkways and improving parking lot safety.



Overview of Projects with a State Match Over Fifty Percent

Fifty-two percent of the Fiscal Year 2016/2017 projects (113 of the 216 projects) were able to take advantage of the option to receive State funding for a flexible match of up to 75% of project costs, with forty-three percent (93 of the 216 projects) receiving the full 75%. *Appendix A* includes a list of these 113 projects.

As illustrated in the chart below, less than ten percent of the available Fiscal Year 2016/2017 capital appropriation of \$19 million, or \$1,815,294, funded that portion of the 113 project awards that exceeded 50 percent.

- State Funding for over 50 percent, up to and including 60 percent,
- State Funding over 60 percent, up to and including 74 percent, and
- State Funding of 75 percent.

Overview of Criteria Used to Document Eligibility for State Match Over 50%

The flexible State match of over 50 percent was requested for 113 projects in Fiscal Year 2016/2017. Library systems used one or more of the criteria included in §273-a of the Education Law to document a project's eligibility for the flexible match.

The criteria used most often by library systems were poverty rates, household income levels, unemployment rates, and free and reduced lunch eligibility data from the New York State Education Department. Some systems used education levels, the number of English language learners, and/or housing values and foreclosure data from the U.S. Census Bureau.

Appendix B lists the types of eligibility criteria used to document match eligibility for each project.

Conclusion

Based upon the information and data described in this statutorily mandated report, the New York State Education Department has determined that changes enacted to §273-a of the Education Law by *Chapter 498 of the Laws of 2011* continue to have a positive impact on public library construction and renovation projects for facilities that are in economically disadvantaged communities. Provisions enacted in 2011 allow for the purchase of vacant land and a flexible match of up to 75 percent in State funds for buildings located in economically disadvantaged communities. There is a March 2020 date in law that would repeal these provisions, if the date is not extended. Another option is to make the provisions permanent in law. Action during the 2018 legislative session is desirable to ensure there are no negative impacts on the program.

Thirty-seven libraries applied for construction funding for the first time in Fiscal Year 2016/2017. Of those, fifteen requested the flexible match.

The flexible match continues to enable more libraries to:

- Improve access to library programs and services for people with disabilities
- Accommodate new technologies
- Increase energy efficiency
- Enhance spaces for programs and collections
- Improve customer service
- Recover from natural disasters
- Create sustainable community partnerships, and
- Leverage other grant funds.
