
CHAPTER 450

AN ACT to amend chapter one thousand seventeen of the laws of nineteen hundred sixty-three, entitled "An act to establish the Uniondale public library district, in the town of Hempstead, Nassau county", in relation to providing for appointment of officers of the library

Became a law May 31, 1966, with the approval of the Governor. Passed by a majority vote, three-fifths being present

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one thousand seventeen of the laws of nineteen hundred sixty-three, entitled "An act to establish the Uniondale public library district, in the town of Hempstead, Nassau County", is hereby amended by adding thereto two new sections to be sections eleven and twelve to read, respectively, as follows:

§ 11. *Officers of the library. The trustees shall at their first meeting each year, elect or appoint a president and vice president, who shall be members of the board and a clerk, treasurer and such other officers as they deem necessary. The clerk and treasurer shall not be members of the board and shall be entitled to receive compensation as fixed by resolution of the trustees.*

§ 12. *The trustees shall be authorized to provide bus transportation for borrowers who reside within the public library district.*

§ 2. Section eleven of such chapter is hereby renumbered thirteen.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
