

## Uniondale Public Library District—Trustees—Vacancies

### CHAPTER 23

An Act to amend chapter ten hundred seventeen of the laws of nineteen hundred sixty-three entitled "An act to establish the Uniondale public library district, in the town of Hempstead, Nassau county", in relation to the filling of vacancies by the board of trustees.

Approved and effective Feb. 20, 1973.

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Section 1. Section eleven of chapter ten hundred seventeen of the laws of nineteen hundred sixty-three entitled "An act to establish the Uniondale public library district, in the town of Hempstead, Nassau county", as added by chapter four hundred fifty of the laws of nineteen hundred sixty-six, is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### § 11. Officers of the library

The trustees shall at their first meeting each year, elect or appoint a president and vice president, who shall be members of the board and a clerk, treasurer and such other officers as they deem necessary. The clerk and treasurer shall not be members of the board and shall be entitled to receive compensation as fixed by resolution of the trustees. In case there is a vacancy on the board of trustees, the board of trustees by a majority vote shall fill the vacancy by appointment, the appointee to serve until a successor is elected at the next election and qualifies for such position.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
