

## LAWS OF NEW YORK, 1999

## CHAPTER 357

AN ACT to amend chapter 672 of the laws of 1993, amending the public authorities law relating to the construction and financing of facilities for certain public libraries, in relation to including the Crandall public library within the provisions of such chapter

Became a law July 27, 1999, with the approval of the Governor.  
Passed by a majority vote, three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 672 of the laws of 1993, amending the public authorities law relating to the construction and financing of facilities for certain public libraries, as separately amended by chapters 164 and 650 of the laws of 1997, is amended to read as follows:

§ 5. The following libraries shall be eligible public libraries for purposes of title 4 of article 8 of the public authorities law:

Comsewogue Public Library  
Rogers Memorial Library Company  
Hendrick Hudson Free Library  
Riverhead Free Library  
Northern Onondaga Public Library District  
Suffern Free Library  
Haverstraw King's Daughters Public Library  
Crandall Public Library

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
