The Youth Television Program 2011 is open to young people between the ages of 13 to 18. Participants will be instructed in the use of professional video equipment (both studio and portable) and will produce a short video project. No previous experience is necessary.

Two sessions are being offered for 2011: July 11th - 28th or August 8th - 25th, and will meet from 9:00 AM until 12 noon on each of these weekdays except Friday.

Classes meet at LCTV's studio at the Kenan Center Arena Annex, 433 Locust, Lockport, NY, and make use of this facility as well as the beautifully landscaped 25-acre Kenan Center campus.

A field trip to video/TV production facilities in Buffalo may be taken on one class day (on this day class will dismiss later than usual). Depending on the subject chosen for students' video, short field trips in Lockport may be taken to such areas as the Erie Canal or Outwater Park (for example). An informal Parents' Reception/Graduation will be held in the evening at a date to be announced for parents, friends and family to view the students' work.
