NYLINE is an e-mail list open to any library or interested individual. NYLINE is a forum for sharing information with any interested library or Internet user in New York State or elsewhere. The New York State Library uses it for official announcements to all subscribers. Many also use NYLINE to post library-related job announcements.

NYLINE alerts subscribers to messages and policy documents or reports available through the New York State Library's web site.

NYLINE is an "unmoderated" list. Once subscribed, your messages are received by nearly 2,700 readers — leaders in libraries and library systems and others interested in New York's libraries.
