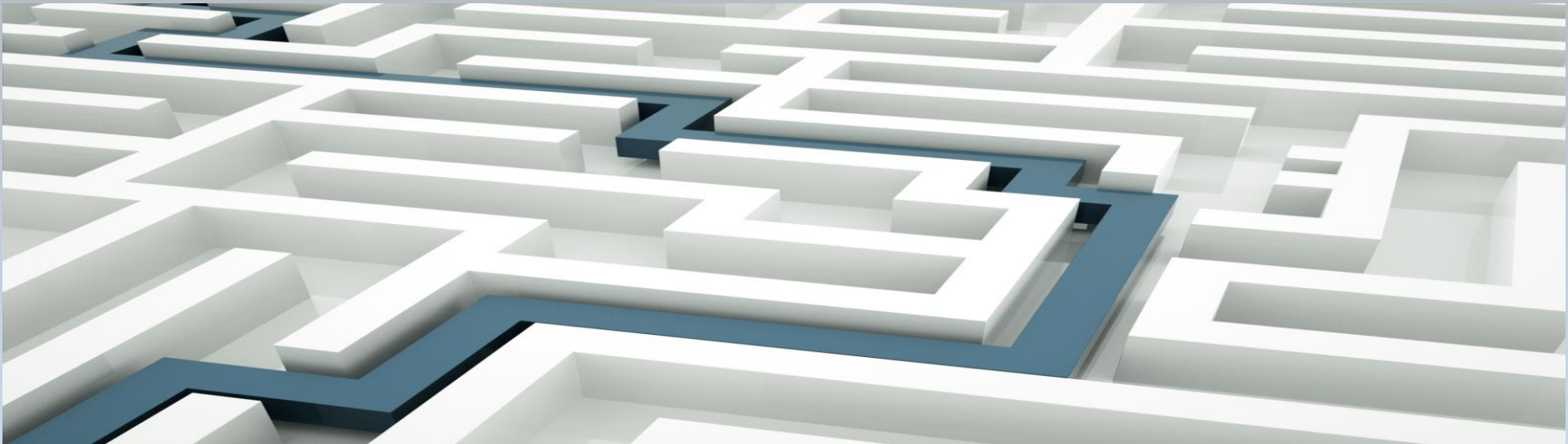

- To Provide a framework for growth & success
 - Community involvement
 - Library Services
 - Technology
 - Personnel
 - Sustainability
 - Capital improvements
 - Budgeting
- To comply with CR §90.2.
- To identify “points of failure” and “points of value”.
- To address important issues before they become urgent problems.



The Basic Steps

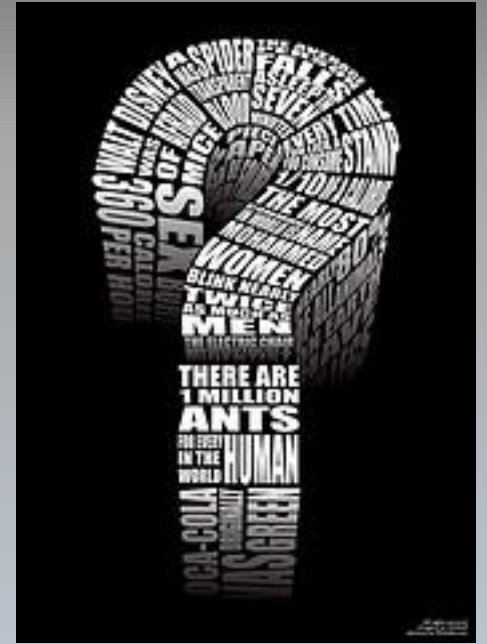
- Develop a Board Vision
- Assess the State of the Library
- Get Input from your Community
- Analyze what you've Learned
- Prioritize and make a Plan
- Evaluate Regularly

Definitions

- **Mission-** *Why does the Library exist?*
- **Vision-** *What does your future look like?*
- **Values-** *What are your core principles?*
- **Long Range Planning-** *Looking toward the future.*
- **Strategic Planning-** *What do we do NOW?*
- **Goals-** *Broad statements of Intent.*
- **Objectives-** *Specific, measurable outcomes.*
- **Activities/Action Steps-** *Actions needed to reach an objective.*
- **Metrics-** *Measurements of activity.*



Developing a Board Vision

- Defining your **Mission**
 - Why do you do what you do??
- Expressing your **Vision**
 - What does your future look like?
- Articulating your **Values**
 - What are your Core beliefs?

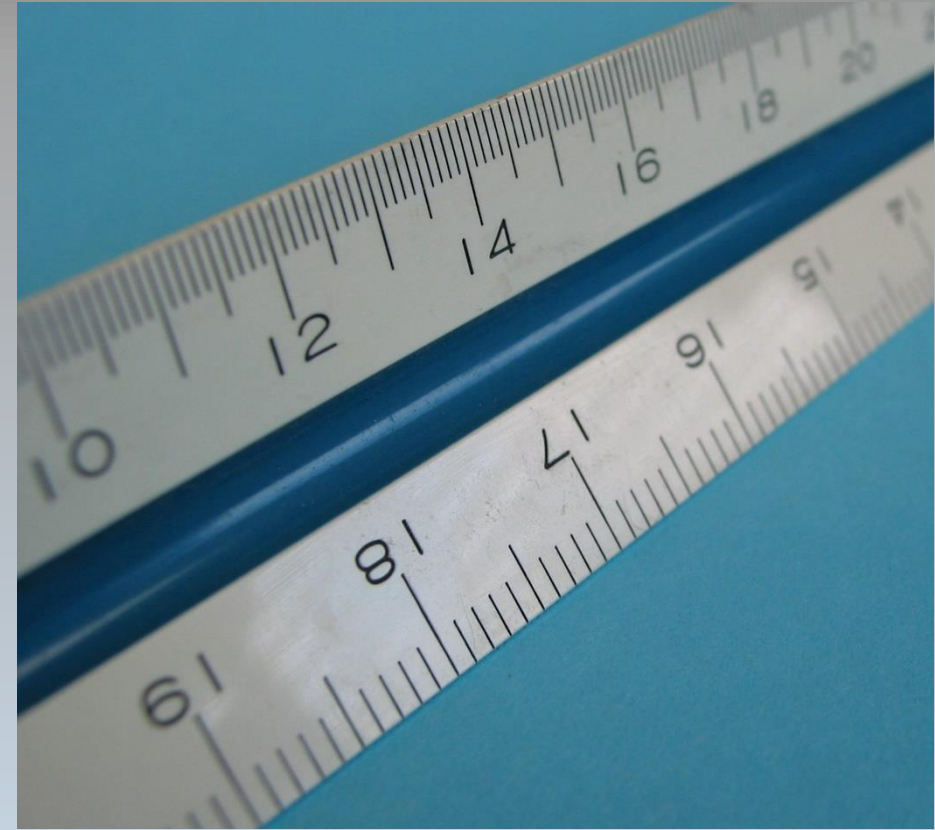
FACT:

“The changes, benefits, learning or other effects that happen as a result of your library's efforts- how you improve your community.”

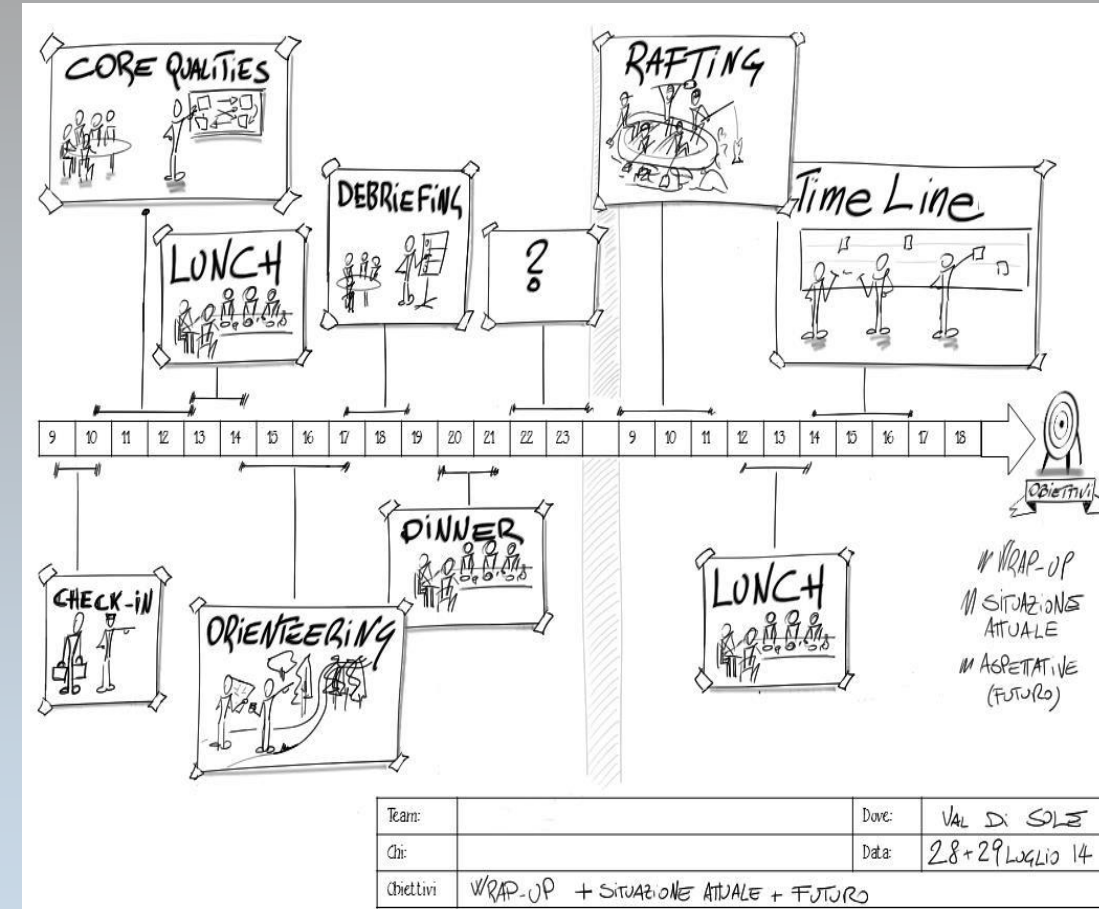

- Objectives
- Activities
- Evaluation Commitment

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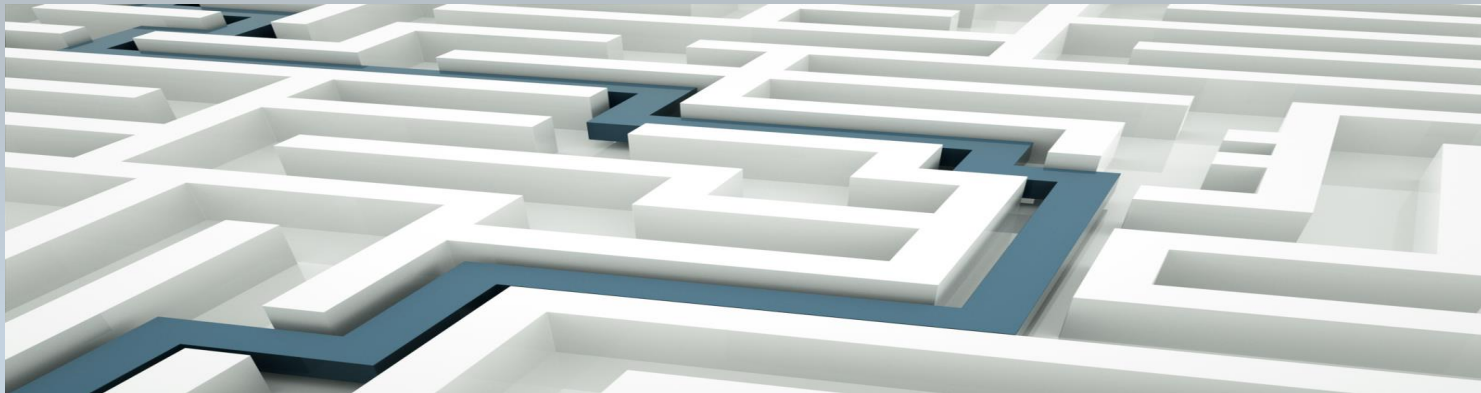
