




State Library Welcomes Forever Free Exhibit

The Library will be hosting *Forever Free: Abraham Lincoln's Journey to Emancipation* from September 3 - October 14, 2010. The exhibit re-examines President Lincoln's thoughts about slavery and includes rare documents and the latest research on how the Emancipation Proclamation came to be. The exhibit will be located on the 7th floor of the New York State Library and will be available for viewing during the Library's regular hours.

To complement the exhibit the Library has planned a complete schedule of programs including scholarly presentations, films, and musical events. For a complete listing of programs see the [schedule of programs](#).

The Library has also revised its [online exhibit](#) that showcases Lincoln's original draft of the Preliminary Emancipation Proclamation, which has been cared for by the Library since 1864. An essay by Harold Holzer about the night Lincoln signed the document and a paper detailing how the Legislature purchased this document for the Library are recent additions to the online exhibit.
