





- Access to a collection of 20 million items including major holdings in law, bio-medicine, social sciences, education, genealogy, newspapers, American and New York State history and culture, life sciences, industry standards and technology

- Free onsite access to 95 online databases and 28,000 full-text e-journals & newspapers
- Access to the largest collection of New York State Government documents and the only complete repository for Federal publications in New York State
- Free WiFi on the 7<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> floors
- 50 computers for public use
- Borrowing books, documents and other materials
- Registration for a NYSL Borrower Card
- Retrieval of materials from closed stacks
- Copiers, scanners and microform reader/printers for public use
