



- [Hathi Trust](#) provides access to over ten million volumes; more than two million of these titles are in the public domain with viewing and downloading options available. Hathi Trust is a partnership of major research institutions and libraries working to ensure that the cultural record is preserved and accessible for future generations.
- [The Digital Book Index](#) has over 165,000 full-text books available from hundreds of commercial and noncommercial publishers, over 140,000 of these are free.
- [Internet Archive's Ebook and Texts Archive](#) provides access to over three million items.
- [The Free Library](#) by Farlex offers close to twenty million books and articles free of charges. This site features a vast collection of classic literature with over 140 authors and their works represented.
