





Looking for current newspaper articles?

Check out America's Newspapers – an online resource available from the State Library. America's Newspapers is a subscription online database that includes over 80 newspapers published in New York State. Some of the newspapers available in this resource are the (Albany) Times Union, Buffalo News, (Massena) Daily Courier-Observer, (Norwich) Evening Sun, New York Post, Newsday, (Syracuse) Post-Standard, Queens Examiner, St. Lawrence Plaindealer (Canton) and Staten Island Advance

You can print, email or export articles found in America's Newspapers. You can also set up email alerts for particular topics. Email alerts are automated searches that run on a regular basis and are automatically emailed to any email address that you specify. Many of the individual sources within America's Newspapers include material that was published online or appeared in print today. However, this does vary from source to source, because of the way that the publishers provide their data.

You can access these online newspapers 24/7 from work or home. As a New York State government employee, you have free and unlimited access to this and other online resources 24/7 with your NYSL Borrower's Card.
