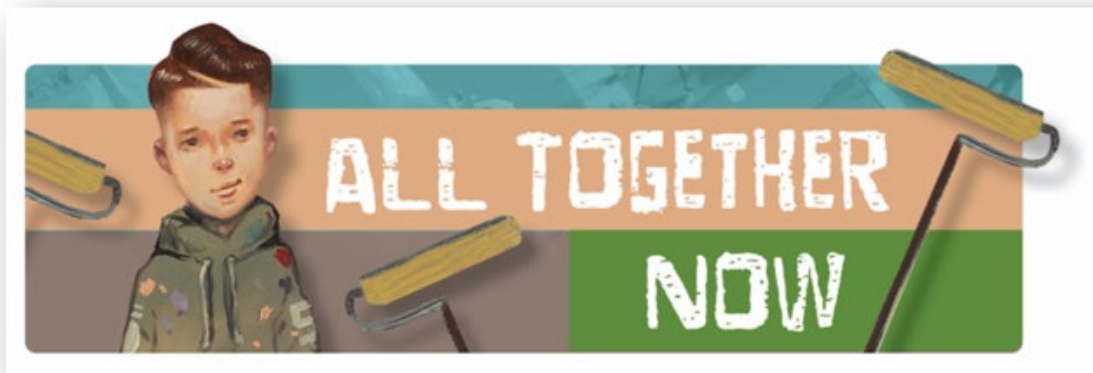




Library Trustees play an important role!
